Dear Colaborers in Christ,

"I bring you tidings of great joy". Christmas celebrates the coming of the One who came to abolish death and bring light and immortality to light through the gospel. Sylvia and I would like to share how this glorious light has shone in Juarez, Mexico.

Bible Institute classes God blessed us with 25 students during our fall semester, with four staff members. The students studied homiletics, Genesis, Doctrines, Life of Christ, Music, and Women in the ministry.

Call of national pastor On Sunday, October 20th, Carlos Diaz was called to be Living Water Baptist Church's new pastor by a 62 to 4 vote. The church now has a Mexican-National pastor, and is supporting him and his family through the tithes of the church, following the indigenous church principle. Praise the Lord!

Revival Conference During the end of October our church participated in our 5th Annual Revival Conference with an average of 300 people during its three days. On the last night seven of our church members surrendered to full-time Christian service, two of which recently entered our Bible Institute to train for the ministry.

Class for special people Rut Castro is a teacher in our small Christian School. This semester she has been teaching four young teenagers with severe mental disabilities. One day I had the privilege to present the plan of salvation to them by illustrating God's love on a white board.

Discipleship Class Sylvia and I are teaching a New Believer's Discipleship class to new believers on Sunday mornings. Sylvia has 15 ladies in her class, and I have eight men. Their hunger for God's Word reminds me of hungry baby birds.

Fall Deputation The Lord opened the door for our family to visit 14 new churches during the past four months. Notable were two teens who received Christ as I taught a class at Pastor David Reyes church in Albuquerque, NM. Several pastors have pledged to start supporting us in 2020. Praise the Lord!

Mexican Refugee Camp News report that 900 refugees fleeing drug cartel violence in Mexican have formed a tent city at the three bridges in Juarez. Sylvia and I have had the privilege to bring them food, personal hygiene kits, and the gospel. We have seen many over twenty saved, and one family has started attending church. We plan to continue to preach the gospel and bring warm blankets and medicines this week.

Ministries Two weeks ago I had the honor of leading nine men to Christ in the Juarez jail, and three in the Drug Rehab Annex. Two are attending our church!
